- A mic and PA system similar to Surround Sound
- Does not project the voice in traditional way - rather it fills the room with sound
- An effective way to ensure everyone hears properly

RedCat



- CPS = Classroom Performance System
- Infrared clicker system with one receiver and 32 response pads
- Allows for immediate assessment of learning in a fun, engaging manner

CPS Clickers



- Plug-in USB stick
- Auto-recognizes
- Allows user to advance and reverse slides from anywhere in the room
- Also has a built-in laser pointer

Power Point Remotes



- A portable, multi-purpose computer tablet
- Includes a Bluetooth keyboard to make typing easier
- Can be used to search the internet, take high quality photos, and record high definition video

iPad



- Allows for video recording to a hard drive rather than a tape
- Provides a much higher quality recording than previous recorders
- Use to record interviews and presentations

HDD Video Camera



- Simply an Apple laptop connected to a projector, on a cart
- Allows Apple users to seamlessly present lessons without converting to a Microsoft program

MacBook & CVP



- Similar in concept to an overhead, but much more advanced
- Can zoom in on and light up objects placed below
- Can take still photos as a screen capture

Document Camera



- An omni directional microphone that connects to the computer via USB
- Auto-recognized by computer
- Great for Skype interviews/presentations as well as webinars

USB Microphone



- Point and shoot cameras that can also record video files
- Images are saved to a memory card
- Can be put onto computer by using a card reader
